



Greetings Parents,

Parents, Thank you for your continued support and involvement in the ministry to our young people. We are excited to say that we continue to add to our number which means there is plenty for all of us to do. Once again, the process of assigning dates for Youth Parents has come. **Some of you are new to this**, so let me take a few moments to explain the meaning behind these assignments. On Sunday nights, the assigned Youth Parents are responsible for providing a meal that they will either cook or order from a nearby restaurant. (Expenses are reimbursed by the youth department up to \$55.00 per night when you turn in your receipts to Delores.) Youth normally meet from 5:00 PM – 6:00 PM. We typically eat from 5:45 – 6:30 PM. Please ask me (Jeff) a week before your assigned date to know how many youth to accommodate in your preparations. (Typically we have around 20-25 students that attend from week to week during the school year and half that during the summer on Sunday Nights. After preparing the food, please utilize the two metal carts (if needed) and bring it to the youth room kitchen around 5:45PM. Makes for fun so that youth can have more hang time in the room they have come to love. We also make it a practice to invite you as a volunteer during any activity scheduled for that month. **Finally, we need to let you know of a change in our programming where we need your assistance.** Youth meet on the fourth Sunday of every month to serve during our normal meeting hour from **5-6 PM**. We ask that the youth parents of a given month chaperon and oversee the Mustard Seed Ministry mission during that time (about 1 hour). **Students will meet you in the parking lot at the Mustard Seed where you will be serving.** *There is NO meal served on this evening. Please feel free to contact me if you have any questions or if I have left something out.

Please look over the attached schedule and determine if you are in need of reassignment. Thank you for your part in assuring the success of this department as we partner in ministering to our students.
